Dan Krug is General Manager of Digital Innovation for Nucor Corporation.

Dan joined Nucor in August of 2002 as Director of Human Resources. In 2013, he became General Manager of Human Resources. In that role, Dan oversaw human resources matters including Succession Management, Leadership & Organizational Development, Selection Systems, Employment Liability, and Workforce Practices for Nucor's nearly 24,000 teammates. In September of 2016, Dan was appointed to the newly created position of General Manager, Digital Innovation. In that role, Dan is responsible for business intelligence and B2B applications.

Prior to working for Nucor, Dan was Vice President of Human Resources for Oldcastle, Inc. Oldcastle is a multi-billion dollar subsidiary of CHR, plc, a Global 500 Irish-based building materials conglomerate. Prior to Oldcastle, Dan worked for Burlington Industries where he served in both human resources and operations roles in four of Burlington's operating facilities before serving as Director of Human Resources for Burlington's House Division.

Dan received an undergraduate degree in Industrial Relations from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill in 1993 and earned an MBA from Virginia Tech in 1996.

Nucor and its affiliates are manufacturers of steel products, with operating facilities primarily in the U.S. and Canada. Products produced include: carbon and alloy steel -- in bars, beams, sheet and plate; hollow structural section tubing; electrical conduit; steel piling; steel joists and joist girders; steel deck; fabricated concrete reinforcing steel; cold finished steel; steel fasteners; metal building systems; steel grating; and wire and wire mesh. Nucor, through The David J. Joseph Company, also brokers ferrous and nonferrous metals, pig iron and hot briquetted iron / direct reduced iron; supplies ferro-alloys; and processes ferrous and nonferrous scrap. Nucor is North America's largest recycler.
